City of Davison Mayor Declares State of Emergency

March 20, 2020

In ongoing measures to protect the residents, businesses, staff and the entire City of Davison, Mayor Tim Bishop has declared until further notice a citywide public health State of Emergency caused by Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). As a result of this pandemic, everyone must stay vigilant, with not only your own health, but the health of your families, neighbors and community. This is not a time for panic, it is a time to take precautions and follow the CDC rules and regulations. The entire City of Davison has the potential to be affected – this pandemic is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death. Schools and businesses have been closed and the impact on health care facilities is severe;

Therefore, as Mayor of the City of Davison, in accordance with Section 10 of 1976 PA 390, as amended, I hereby declare that a "state of emergency" exists within our jurisdiction as of March 20, 2020, and that local resources are being utilized to the fullest possible extent. The response elements of our emergency operations have been activated by the Federal, State and Local levels.

Until further notice, city hall, is open to staff only. Staff is currently available by phone, email, fax, and drop-box. All meetings, including; boards, authorities, committees and council are cancelled until further notice.
